About 1,000 BM pastors came from Sarawak, Sabah and Semenanjung to the Pastors and Leaders Conference in Kuching.

Both Pr. John Mulinde and Pr. Philip Mantofa stressed on the need and urgency for evangelism. The pastors were clearly charged up to obey the Great Commission when they return home to their churches in the interior.
