REVIVAL AMONG PENANS IN SARAWAK

Since May 2023, the Holy Spirit has fallen in power over the Penans tribe in the interior of Sarawak. Revival fire was ignited among the Penans.

It started in the Penan village of Long Kevok where the Holy Spirit fell last year. Deliverances from the occult were rampant, rededications and salvations of souls were common and reconciliations of longtime friends and fractured relationships took place. God was on the move among the Penans. The revival spread to several Penan villages throughout Sarawak.

SIBKL sent a team consisting of Pastors and Elders in March this year together with members of the Pusat BEM Sarawak to ascertain if the revival is genuine. They visited the Penan village of Long Kevok. Their report was that the revival that is on-going among the Penans is real and authentic. Village after village among the Penans are revived.

To-date, the revival is still on-going and it has recently spread even to the nearby Kayan villages.
